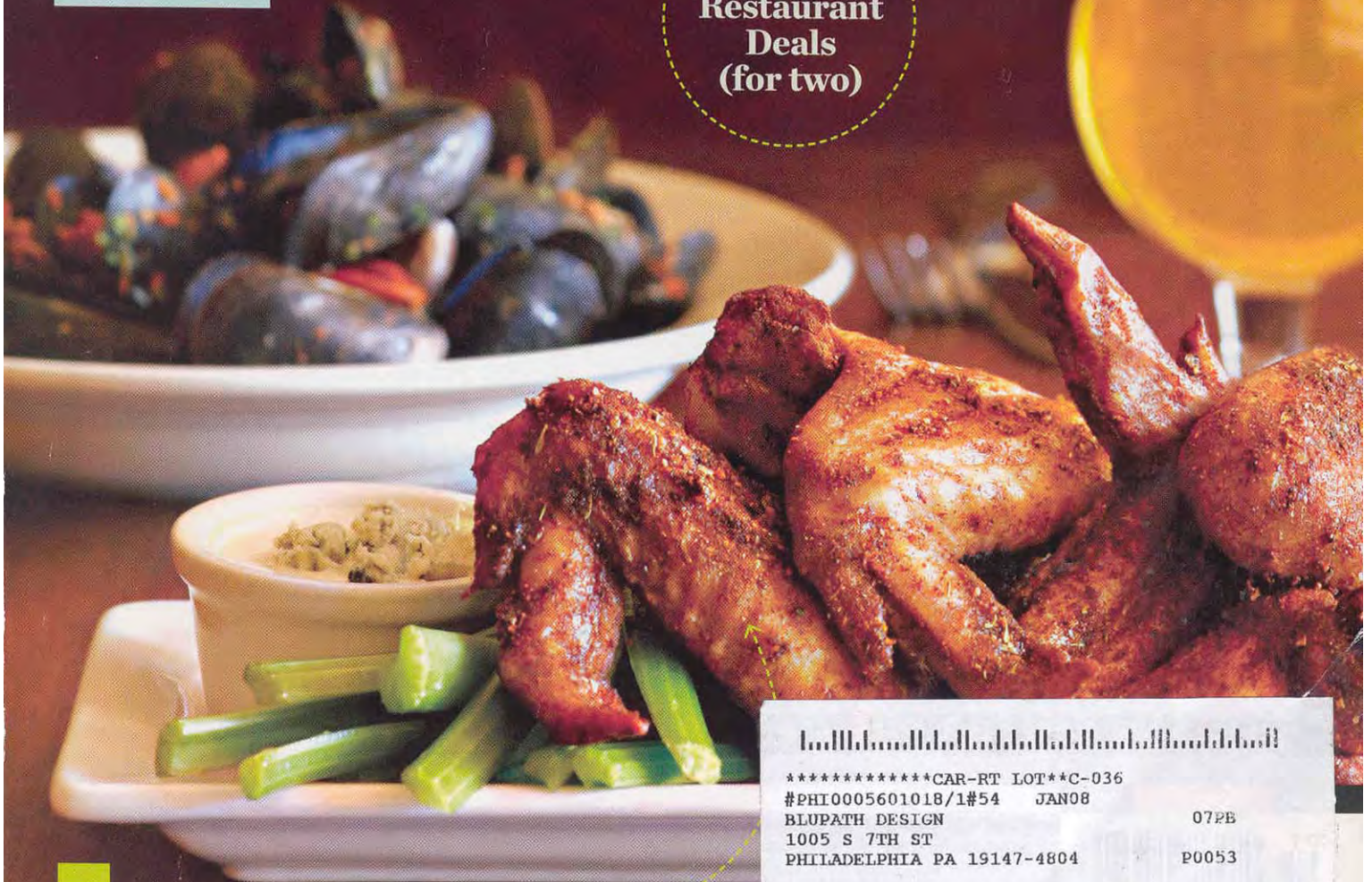

This winning kitchen features a Wolf warming drawer, microwave oven, built-in single oven and Sub-Zero refrigerator.

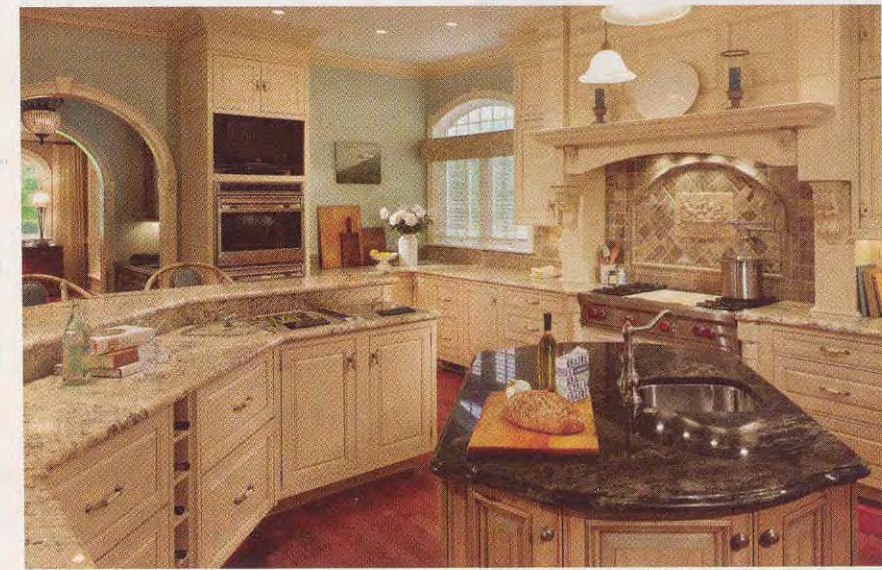

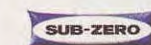
